

Linked Data

Four Rules:

- 1. Use URIs as names for things.
- 2. Use HTTP URIs so that people can look up those names.
- 3. When someone looks up a URI, provide useful information.
- 4. Include links to other URIs, so that they can discover more things.

Mostly in carrier description (physical description):

When a 264 is used, can distinguish between functions (publication, distribution, publication, manufacture)

- First place of publication, order it appears on the resource
- Dates in roman numerals no longer converted to Arabic numerals
